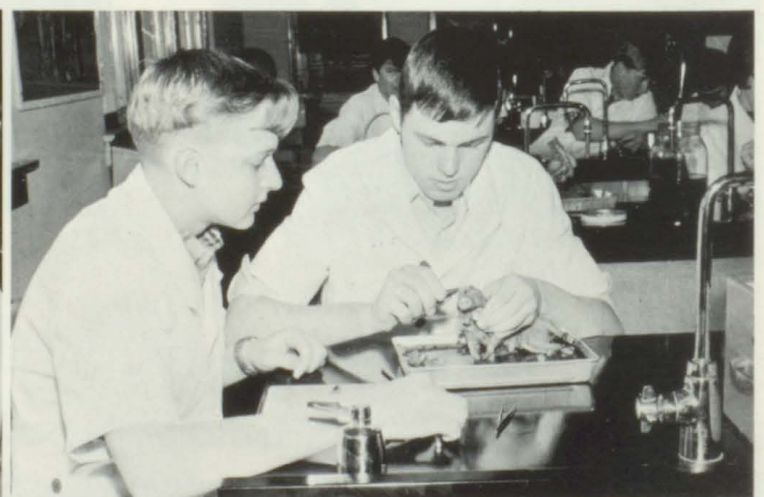
## SCIENCE
