



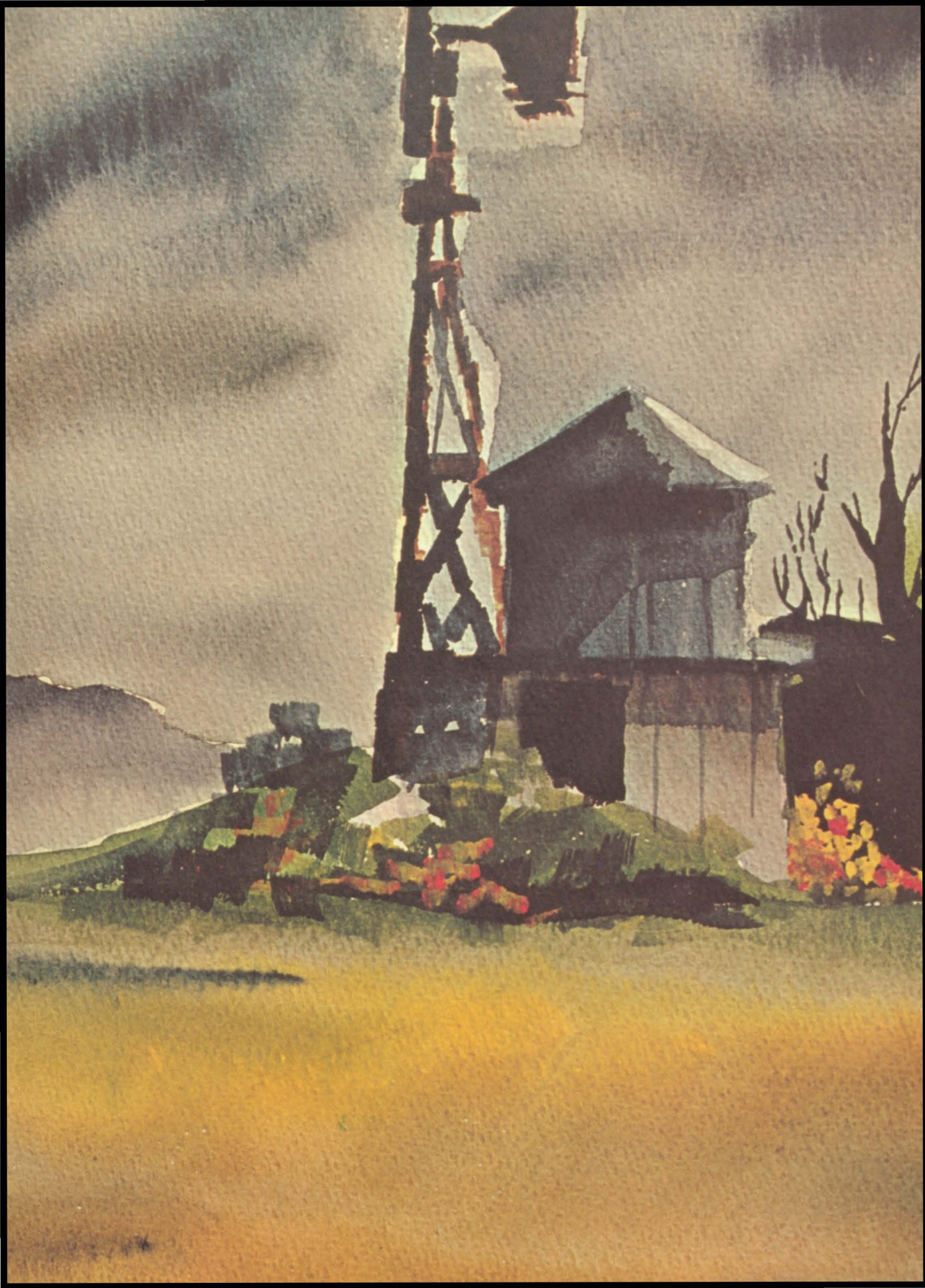

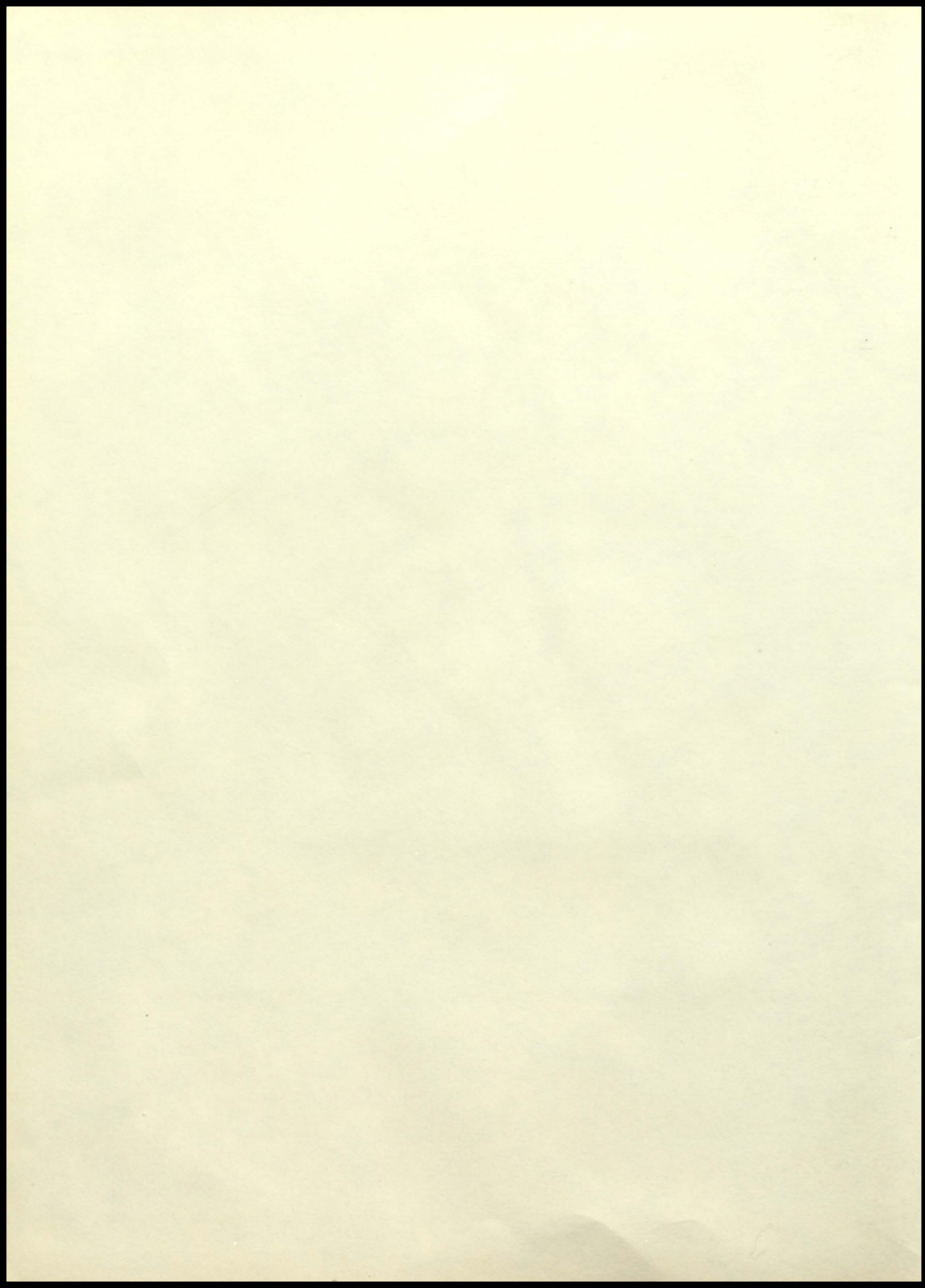

in the mountains.

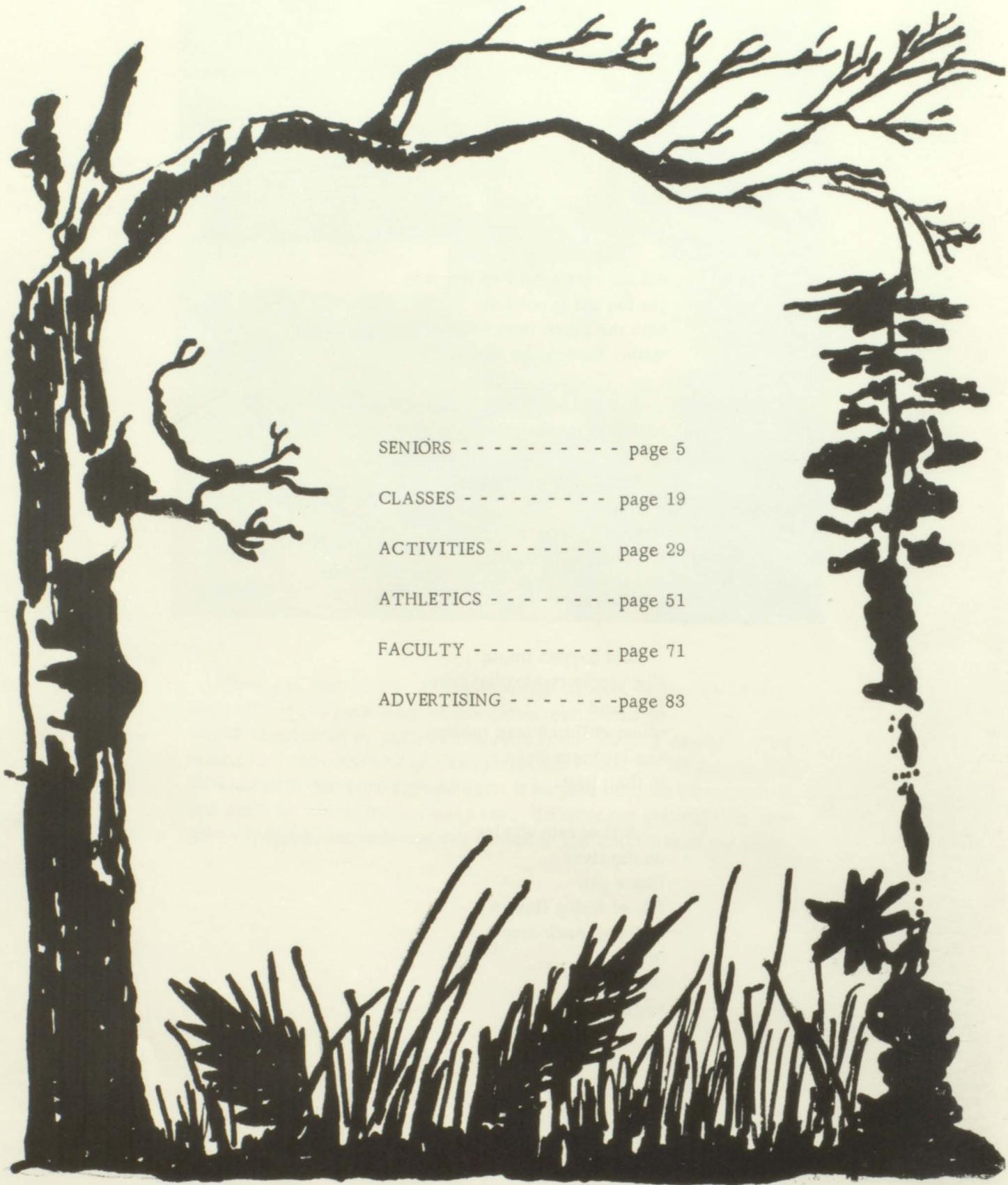
It is a warm green rain
