Augusta students had an opportunity this year to learn about South America. Our foreign exchange student for the $1985-86$ school year was Ivana Pereira Goulart. Ivana's home is in Goiania, a city in Brazil. Ivana's American family was Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Smith. She says she likes her new family and had felt at home since she arrived.
Goiania has a population of $1,000,000$. She said, however, that a city of 75,000 is small. When applying for foreign exchange, she asked to be placed in a small city. She was expecting one with a population of around 75,000 to 100,000 . She said, however, she likes Augusta because it is so small. She likes the people, also. She describes the citizens as friendly and talkative. She also likes the school, but wishes it was more like hers in Brazil.
In Brazil school hours are from 7:00 in the morning until noon. The students do not have studyhalls or lunch periods. Students remain in the same classroom throughout the day. She said this is better, because students have an opportunity to become closer to their classmates. They become friends instead of classmates.
Teens in Brazil have the same recreational pastimes as teens in America, she noted. The exception she said is that the United States has a minimum drinking age, Brazil does not. This is better she said, because teens in America drink because it is prohibited. In Brazil drinking is not as popular, because there is not a controversy over it.

Ivana noted a few differences between Brazil and America. Number one on her list is the language. Radio stations in Brazil play a variety of music in different languages from several countries. Incidentally, her favorite Brazilian singer is Milton Nascimento and her favorites in America are Phil Collins, Lionel Richie, and Madonna. Another major difference for Ivana was the seasonal weather. Brazil is always summer-like. She adores autumn and loves the color change in the trees. She said it is like a post card. Ivana anticipates her first snowfall and thinks she will like it. She said, however, she may not like the cold. It very rarely reaches a low of $2^{\circ}$ Celcius or $36^{\circ}$ Fahrenheit in Brazil. The weather is normally $20^{\circ}$ to $40^{\circ}$ Celcius.

Ivana thinks the student exchange program is "great." She noted that it is a good learning experience. She hopes students in Augusta will take advantage of the program and go to Brazil.
